CO<sub>2</sub>OP UG hereby confirms that

## KMF GmbH, Kunststoff-Metall-Formteile

has offset its corporate greenhouse gas footprint determined by us in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Standard<sup>1</sup> in scope 1+2 balance sheet framework and one of 15 categories from scope 3 for the year 2023 by purchasing CO2<sub>e</sub> certificates in the amount of 15 metric tons.

The company has already reduced its gross emissions of 47.97 tons by 33.58 tons to 14.39 tons by feeding in PV electricity from its own systems.

The company is therefore net carbon neutral for the year 2023<sup>2</sup>

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The term "net carbon neutrality" means that the company in question did not cause any net greenhouse gas emissions into the atmosphere during the period under review. The company's measured GHG emissions were offset by emission savings of the same amount elsewhere by third parties and thus compensated for. The offset emissions could not have yet been avoided.
